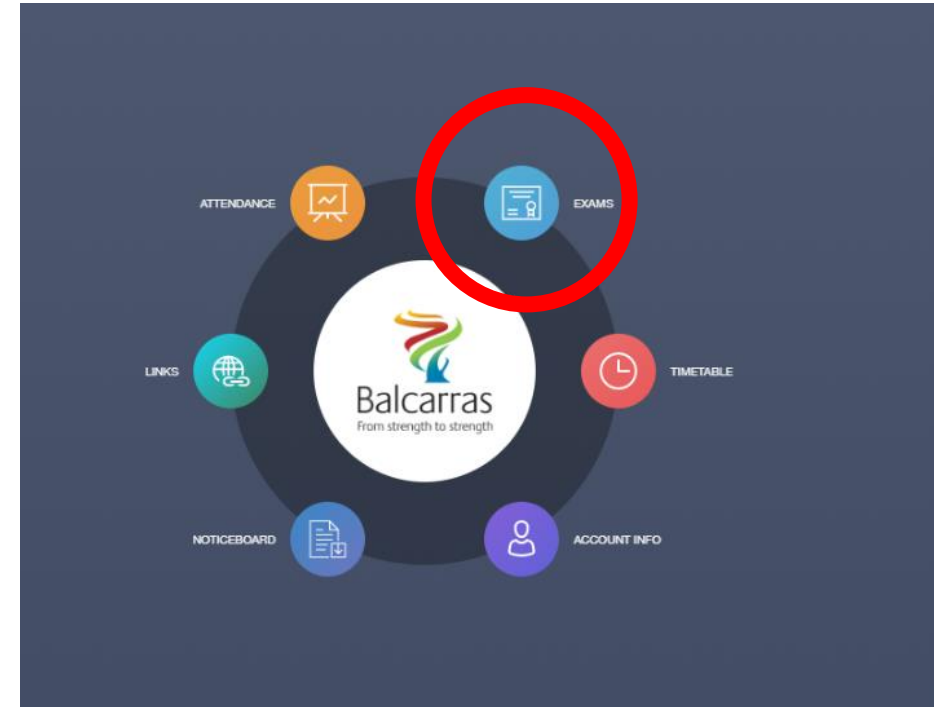

- 1. Go to <https://www3.edulinkone.com/#!/login>**
- 2. In 'school ID or postcode' type Balcarras then click Next**
- 3. Username are the 4 numbers you use to log on in school**
- 4. Password is the same Password you use to log on to the VLE ETC**
- 5. Select the [exams button](#) to see your results.**

Results Days Guidance

Results Days Guidance

In order for the collection of results proceed safely, please do follow the following guidance:

- **If you are planning to collect your results at school please only come to school if you feel well.**
- **On arriving at the Main Hall, please use the hand sanitiser provided.**
- **Only students will be able to collect their results in the Main Hall.**
- **If after the collection of your results you do need to consult with staff, please keep to the one way system and following the social distancing arrangements set out on the floor and in the Sixth Form Common Room.**
- **Members of staff regrettably will not be able to shake your hand in greeting**
- **Consultation meetings will be held in classrooms in the Sixth Form block where we can ensure social distancing as required.**
- **When you are leaving, please exit via the sixth Form entrance.**

If after attending the school you feel unwell with COVID-19 symptoms (*a new, continuous cough or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell*) or know that you have come into contact with anyone else with COVID-19 symptoms in the 7 days before your visit then you will contact the school as soon as possible.
