 - (C2) 'Breathless'

 - (C11) 'Piggy screamed'
 - (C11) 'His head opened and stuff came out'
 - (C12) '(Ralf wept for the end of innocence, the darkness of man's heart and) for the fall through the air of the true, wise friend called Piggy.'

- (EVENT 1) Piggy's glasses are taken in chapter 2 to light the fire.
