## Unifrog tasks

**Work Environments Quiz:** learn more about the environments you enjoy and explore which careers suit your preferences best

**Post-16 Intentions:** record your intentions after GCSEs

**Courses:** Unifrog has a range of online courses students can take in three areas

- ✓ **Careers and virtual work experience:** Help students explore careers (eg 'How to start a business'), do virtual work experience (eg a course where students experience being an architect by designing a structure for animals), and develop career readiness skills (eg a course on how to behave in the workplace).
- ✓ **Subject tasters:** Give students an idea of what studying a particular subject is like, (e.g. a course giving students a taste of studying maths at university: 'The Size of Infinity').
- ✓ **PSHE and life skills:** Help students develop as people and citizens (e.g. a course on how to set goals and write plans).
