Prior Learning (Topic)		

Composition- Students will experiment and take increasing risks as the instructions develop. Through a series of ever increasing and complex instructions develop an understanding of Abstract art. Intent

- Building on K3 skills students will learn about the elements of composition and design and learn how to take risks and that the process of making art is just that: a process.
- Students can access the course confidently that cannot fail the initial tasks and are familiar with some of the terminology; especially around the discussions around colour.
- Students also further see how the context in which they are working is increasingly imperative and begin to make strong links between their work and the work of others.

Implementation

- Increasingly complex composition instructions followed- a discussion on the different types of harmonious compositionsymmetrical, asymmetrical radial.
- Relevant artists work discussed/reviewed

Students will review their work and comment with increasing confidence on their progress. They will evaluate their outcomes and make informed connections with the work of others.

Impact

- Practical skills are assessed with regard to being able to review, refine and control materials, processes and techniques. (Assessment Objective 2) Final outcomes are assessed by the quality with which a student has presented a personal response which is clearly supported by their research. They will realise their intentions in a technically convincing and creative way. (Assessment Objective 4)
- Personal annotation will be assessed by the quality of insight and understanding demonstrated. Writing will be personal and thoughtful. (Assessment objective 3)
- Students will be taking increased ownership of their work, developing and experimenting with increased independence.
