Further discussions will be had around the topic of developing an idea further and how artists use working methods to find their voice. Appropriate terminology used around these discussions especially around the use of material choice and expression. Students continue to see how the context in which they are working is increasingly imperative and begin to make strong links/choices between their work and the work of others.
