Through a series of investigative stages now familiar – students work to develop their own response and initial discussions take placeStudents at this point will have the opportunity to take their recognised skill set to investigate a topic which is meaningful to them. Students will again experiment and take increasing risks with drawing/painting processes and materials. Building on previous skills students will revisit and experiment with the rudiments of 'expression'. They will further learn how to take risks and that the process of making art is just that: a process involving practise and enquiry. Students can access the course safely and confidently, knowing that if they follow the guidelines, they will develop a new response through to conclusion. Continuous discussions will be held around the topic of developing an idea - and artists' use of working methods to find their voice continually referred to. Students will be involved in 2 weekly group tutorials where there can be a sharing of ideas/methodologies amongst the students and teachers. Appropriate terminology used around these discussions especially around the use of material choice and expression. Students continue to see how the context in which they are working is increasingly imperative and begin to make strong links/choices between their work and the work of others.
