Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic)

This unit will build on the skills taught in the Improvisation and Melodrama units in Year 8. Students will have explored 'comedy' as a genre in Year 7 and 8 but not have necessarily had any explicit teaching of the genre and its conventions.

This unit introduces students to the genre of comedy and different types of comedy. It is also an opportunity to build on the improvisation skills taught in Year 8.

Lessons will include:

- ✓ What makes a piece of drama funny?
- ✓ Exploration of different types of comedy including farce, slapstick, stand-up comedy, dark comedy.
- ✓ How to create comedy characters and exploration of caricature.
- ✓ Improvisation games and exercises.
- ✓ Performance and evaluation
