Theatre in Education and an Introduction to Brecht

Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic)

This unit builds on devising work that students have completed in the Spring Term.

This unit introduces students to a second key practitioner: Brecht. In this unit students will explore a few of his methods and try to apply them to their own performance. Students will also be introduced to T.I.E as a genre and have the opportunity to perform in this style.

Lessons will include:

- ✓ Introduction to T.I.E as a genre. What is Theatre in Education? Why is it effective?
- ✓ What themes are currently relevant and applicable to Theatre in Education?
- ✓ Who is Brecht? An introduction to the practitioner.
- ✓ Introduction to Brecht's methods including Breaking the Fourth Wall and Direct Address.
- ✓ Performance and evaluation
