Content (Intent)		
<p><b>Prior Learning (Topic):</b> places in town , verb conjugations, expressing opinions, accusative and prepositional cases, adjectival agreement, compass points</p> <p>Students will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to describe activities that can be done in their region</li> <li>- to give directions and use prepositions</li> <li>- how to compare life in the town and the countryside</li> <li>- GRAMMAR: expressing possibilities using можно / нельзя+ infinitive of verb</li> <li>- SKILLS: how to approach GCSE style reading and listening tasks.</li> </ul>		
<p><b>Future Learning (Topic):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- environmental issues in a town (Yr 11, Autumn 1)</li> </ul>
