# **Content (Intent)**

# Prior Learning (Topic): Ordering food in a restaurant, music festivals, jobs

# Students will learn:

How to discuss plans for the future in terms of job and life aspirations. Students will learn how to talk about healthy eating and will consider local and global issues (unemployment, animals in danger of extinction, drug addition, hunger, recycling, use of public transport, wasting energy). Students will learn how to give commands.

**Grammar**: The present subjunctive and its use with cuando, indirect object pronouns, the conditional tens, different structures to express future plans.

#### How can parents help at home?

One of the most helpful ways that parents can help is through helping pupils to learn vocabulary. It doesn't matter if you don't know any Spanish yourself. Encourage your child to be 'active' in the learning and not 'passive' i.e. they should write the words down or speak them out several times, or even record themselves. Parents can then test them by saying the English and the child either has to spell it out or write it down.
