Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic): history of Moscow and its tourist attractions; formation of USSR; life in USSR before Gorbachev (Yr 12, Summer 2); Grammar (Yr 12)

Students will learn:

- differences between life in the centre of Moscow and the suburbs
- immigration in Moscow and related issues
- what is 'Perestroika'
- economical changes in the USSR and outcomes of Gorbachev's economic strategies GRAMMAR:
 - revision of Year 12 grammar (adjective and noun declensions; verbal aspects)
 - short form adjectives
 - себя and reflexives verbs
 - negatives (type2)
 - cardinal and ordinal numerals
 - common examples of collective numerals (двое детей)
