Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic): Immigration and Young people today

Students will learn about:

Racism, measures to combat racism and anti-racism legislation. Additionally, students will complete work on the Franco dictatorship, Latin American dictators, and the evolution of monarchy.

Finally, students will concentrate on studying the set play 'Las bicicletas son para el verano'. Once in a fortnight, a lesson will be dedicated to understanding plot lines and subsequent analysis of character, context, themes, and other aspects in the set work.

Finally, students will also dedicate a large chunk of time in this half term to the Independent Research Project.
