## **Content (Intent)**

# Prior Learning (Topic): Year 7 Term 3 pupils learn about school

### Students will learn about:

- Recap a range of key vocabulary from Year 7 topics.
- Talking about which free time activities they do + that other people do
- Using frequency phrases to say how often they do these activities.
- Giving developed opinions about sports.
- Describing how sporty they are. /Talking about which sports they do and play.
- Describing the weather; saying which sports they play in different weather and seasons.

#### Grammar:

- using the present tense of regular -ER verbs in the first person + other forms
- focusing on the gender of nouns related to sport.
- using prepositions with 'jouer' and 'faire'.
- using opinion verbs with infinitives.

### How can parents help at home?

One of the most helpful ways that parents can help is through helping pupils to learn vocabulary. It doesn't matter if you don't know any French yourself. Encourage your child to be 'active' in the learning and not 'passive' ie they should write the words down or say them out loud them several times, or even record themselves. Parents can then test them by saying the English and the child either has to spell it out or write it down.
