Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic):

- Russian alphabet and basic introductions (greetings, names, age, how are you?).

Students will learn:

- The differences between lower- and upper-case letters in Russian.
- Family members and pets
- How to say 'I have...' and express simple opinions
- Simple connectives (and, but, however)
- GRAMMAR: Using the third person to talk about others (he is called... / she is ... years old, etc)

Future Learning (Topic):

- Using the 3rd person is one of the criteria to access higher grades in KS3.

How will knowledge and skills be taught? (Implementation)	How will your understanding be assessed & recorded (Impact)
Listening and reading activities Writing a short paragraph in Russian Classwork on phonics Repetition	Pupils will complete a listening, reading and written assessment on their knowledge of topics covered in Autumn 1, Autumn 2 and Spring 1 terms. Pupils will receive a grade for each skill.

How can parents help at home?

Encourage regular revision of the Russian alphabet and vocabulary at home.

Pupils often find teaching their parents the structures and vocabulary they have learnt a good technique to reinforce their own understanding.

Use independent study booklet.

Direct learners to the resources available on the VLE for verification or if they think they are missing class notes.
