Prior Learning (Topic): - Russian alphabet and basic introductions (greetings, names, age, how are you?). Students will learn: - The capital letters and differences between lower- and upper-case letters in cursive Russian. - Family members and pets - How to say 'I have...' and express simple opinions - Simple connectives (and, but, however) - GRAMMAR: Using the third person to talk about others (he is called... / she is ... years old, etc)		
Future Learning (Topic): - Using the 3rd person is one of the criteria to access higher grades in KS3.

Listening and reading activities Writing a short paragraph in Russian Classwork on phonics Repetition	Pupils will complete a listening, reading and written assessment on their knowledge of topics covered in Autumn 1, Autumn 2 and Spring 1 terms. Pupils will receive a grade for each skill.
