My town: what it is like and what is the weather is like		
Content (Intent)		
Prior Learning (Topic): - where I live, describing places in town.		
Students will learn:		
- How to write a description of the town where they live - Phrases to describe different types of weather conditions - CULTURE: Learn about climate in different parts of Russia. (Moscow vs Siberia) - GRAMMAR: Reinforce prepositional endings to talk about the weather in different cities around the world.		
Future Learning (Topic): - Weather phrases can be used in free time assessment (Year 9, Spring 1) and will be developed in the ‘Holiday’ topic (Year 10, Autumn 1)		
How will knowledge and skills be taught? (Implementation)	How will your understanding be assessed & recorded (Impact)	
Listening and reading activities. Writing sentences to reflect their understanding of vocabulary and grammar. Repetition and speaking activities.	Pupils will write a paragraph about where they live (*with correct adjectival endings and examples of the prepositional case). Pupils will receive a grade for this task. Pupils will do a speaking assessment to show their knowledge of topics covered in Spring 2, Summer 1 and 2 terms. Pupils will receive a grade for the task.	
How can parents help at home?
