- The Russian alphabet (part 1 to part 4)

- Vocabulary to introduce themselves здравствуй(те) (hello), меня зовут (ту name is), как дела? (how are you?)
- Russian culture: How Russian names work

Classwork on phonics Repetition	Pupils will be tested on each part of the alphabet and should be expected to know all the letters from part 1-4.

## How can parents help at home?

Encourage regular revision of the Russian alphabet at home.

Pupils often find teaching their parents what they have learnt about the alphabet a good technique to reinforce their own understanding.
