My town: Places in town		
Content (Intent)		
<p>Prior Learning (Topic):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Russian alphabet, where I live, compass points, *prepositional case. 		
<p>Students will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 20 items of vocabulary for places in town (school, shop, park, etc) - To describe which places are in a town using <i>есть</i> (there is/are) - Basic adjectives to describe places in town (big, small, new, old) - CULTURE: Learn about famous buildings in Moscow and St Petersburg - GRAMMAR: How to identify gender of a Russian noun and explore how this affects adjectival endings 		
<p>Future Learning (Topic):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adjectives (Year 9, Spring 2) and 'Town' topic (Year 10, Autumn 2) 		
How will knowledge and skills be taught? (Implementation)	How will your understanding be assessed & recorded (Impact)	
Listening and reading activities Writing sentences to reflect their understanding of vocabulary and grammar	Pupils will have regular tests on key vocabulary Pupils will write a paragraph about where they live (*with correct adjectival endings and examples of the prepositional case). Pupils will receive a grade for this task.	
How can parents help at home?		
<p>Encourage regular revision of vocabulary at home. Pupils often find teaching their parents the structures and vocabulary they have learnt a good technique to reinforce their own understanding. Use independent study booklet.
