My town: Where I live		
Content (Intent)		
Prior Learning (Topic): - Russian alphabet, basic greetings, numbers, family and pets.		
Students will learn: - How to say where they live and ask where somebody lives - Compass points to describe where a town is - CULTURE: The names of Russian towns/cities and how they are spelt in Russian - GRAMMAR: Conjugation of the verb жить (to live) in the 'I', 'you', 'he' and 'she' forms - *GRAMMAR: Use the prepositional case after в (in) and на (on) to form simple sentences		
Future Learning (Topic): - Verb conjugation (Year 9, Autumn 1) and 'Town' topic (Year 10, Autumn 2)		
How will knowledge and skills be taught? (Implementation)	How will your understanding be assessed & recorded (Impact)	
Revision of the alphabet through learning of new vocabulary. Listening and reading activities Writing sentences to reflect their understanding of grammar.	Pupils' understanding of structures will be assessed through class activities in their work booklet and through speaking activities in class.
