Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic): Talking about school

Students will learn how to talk and write about:

their breaktime activities & what they can do. They will also learn to talk about what they are going to do in the future.

Grammar: Reinforcement of the use of verbs of opinion + infinitive; introduction to more verbs which are followed by the infinitive (se puede – you can..); introduction of the near future tense (voy a + infinitive)

Key vocabulary: school subjects, connectives, likes & dislikes, adjectives, verbs in the infinitive

How can parents help at home?

One of the most helpful ways that parents can help is through helping pupils to learn vocabulary. It doesn't matter if you don't know any Spanish yourself. Encourage your child to be 'active' in the learning and not 'passive' ie they should write the words down or speak them out several times, or even record themselves. Parents can then test them by saying the English and the child either has to spell it out or write it down.

Youtube is also a great resource for hearing and practising vocabulary.
