Content (Intent)		
Prior Learning (Topic): See year 8 Summer term		
<p>Students will learn about: How to use the present tense (recap from year 8) and to talk about which countries they go to. They will also learn how to say where they went on a past holiday; with whom they went and their opinion of it. Students will also learn to describe activities that they did whilst on holiday using sequencer. Grammar: Present tense, preterite tense of 'ir' – to go, adjectival agreements, exclamations using "¡Qué + adjective!", sequencers.</p>

How can parents help at home?		
<p>One of the most helpful ways that parents can help is through helping pupils to learn vocabulary. It doesn't matter if you don't know any Spanish yourself. Encourage your child to be 'active' in the learning and not 'passive' i.e. they should write the words down or speak them out several times, or even record themselves. Parents can then test them by saying the English and the child either has to spell it out or write it down. YouTube and Quizlet is also a great resource for hearing and practising vocabulary.
