Hispanic food, quantities and giving an account of a party

Content (Intent)

Prior Learning (Topic): New year's resolutions & Hispanic food, mealtimes and telling the time

Students will learn about:

Students will reuse the vocabulary from the previous term. Students will learn how to order a meal in a restaurant using the formal 'you' in Spanish. Students will learn how to express different quantities of foods (e.g. a bottle, a packet, 500g, 1kg) and talk about what they are going to buy for a party in the future. Students will learn how to give an account using three tenses. **Grammar**: Infinitive structures, present tense, preterite tense, near future tense, using negatives (never, not, nothing), adjectival agreements.

How can parents help at home?

One of the most helpful ways that parents can help is through helping pupils to learn vocabulary. It doesn't matter if you don't know any Spanish yourself. Encourage your child to be 'active' in the learning and not 'passive' i.e. they should write the words down or speak them out several times, or even record themselves. Parents can then test them by saying the English and the child either has to spell it out or write it down.
