### • Sixth Form

- To attend our sixth form you need two 6s and three 5s at GCSE including English and Maths

## **Dropping Subjects**

There is a common misconception amongst pupils that you can "drop" GCSEs that are not going well.

This is not the case.

Pupils have to be in a lesson and supervised at all times. There is no capacity for them to not go to a particular lesson.
