Entry requirements

- A minimum of 2 grade 6s and 3 grade 5s (full course GCSE)
- At least a 5 in mathematics and English (Literature or Language)
- There is no requirement about your geographical location!
- Everyone studies 4 A-levels



Each year, many students apply from schools other than Balcarras. The benefit they bring to the sixth form, both socially and academically, is immensely valued. However, we are only able to accommodate 50 external students.

In the event that more than 50 students wish to take up a place in Year 12, students will be allocated places based on the over subscription criteria set out on the school's website.



Private Study



Our students do not have 'free' periods. If a student is not in a subject lesson, we timetable them into Study, where they are able to access fantastic resources to make progress in their subjects, complete homework, and establish effective study skills.



Post-18 destinations beyond Balcarras

Each academic year, over 75% of Balcarras' Year 13 cohort will complete UCAS applications and go on to study at university. Each year we see a number of our students make Early Entry applications to read courses at Oxbridge colleges, or to study courses in medicine, veterinary science or dentistry, and go on to successfully take up their places in the autumn. A significant number are also supported in their preparation for additional entrance exams for other courses, such as law.

At the same time, we fully support all prospective destinations, and regardless of whether you are seeking a university course, an apprenticeship or employment, or whether you are pursuing a STEM-related future, or one in the arts, you will receive our full support and guidance to help you achieve your goals.
