It is vital that the deadlines for payment and return of the "Starter Form" are met – $\underline{\text{Monday }10^{\text{th}}\text{ July}}$ 2023. Late applications will be considered, but it will be more difficult to accommodate pupils whose applications are late. We will try and accommodate all pupils, however waiting lists will be established if lessons are oversubscribed.

Extracurricular Music

There is an expectation for students to participate regularly in at least one Music Extracurricular activity if having lessons in school. Please indicate which group(s) your son/daughter will commit to. Current provision includes: Choirs, Brass Group, String Group, Woodwind Group, Orchestra, Balcajazz, Sambalca and Boys' Singers.

Practice and Practice Rooms

Obviously, to make progress, students need to be practising on a regular basis. Practice Rooms can be booked for use before and after school and at lunchtime. Rooms can be booked for the week ahead by seeing any member of the Music Department.

Fee structure 2023-2024

Music tuition fees are collected twice yearly (Block 1 and Block 2), based on fifteen lessons per block.

We collect payments for music lessons in advance. The school online payment system is available for music tuition fees. We encourage ALL to register to pay for future payments in this way. Payment can be made using a credit or debit card. If you require your child's login details together with instructions, please email Mrs S Davis sed@balcarras.gloucs.sch.uk for a copy to be emailed to you.

It is possible to pay in monthly instalments by setting up a Standing Order. Five lessons have to be paid for initially and a Standing Order can be set up to divide remaining payments across nine months, September to May. Please contact email Mrs S Davis sed@balcarras.gloucs.sch.uk if you wish to arrange this.

Cancellation of lessons

Lessons cannot be terminated before the end of block $\bf 1$. If a student wishes to terminate lessons, there is a notice period of five lessons. For example, if a student wishes to terminate lessons at the end of block $\bf 1$, notice must be given by lesson $\bf 10$.

Lesson Times

Lessons are timetabled and displayed on the instrumental tuition board (in the music entrance lobby). Students should check their lesson time at the beginning of the week, **before AM reg**, to ensure they know when their lesson will take place.

Missed lessons

If a student knows in advance that they will miss a lesson for any reason, they need to inform their instrumental teacher at least eight clear days in advance. In this case, the instrumental teacher will endeavour to reorganise the lesson for a later date (although this cannot be guaranteed) and no extra cost will be incurred. This includes lessons missed for school trips, internal assessments, and so forth.

If a student misses a lesson and does not inform the teacher at least eight clear days in advance the lesson will <u>not</u> be reorganised and will be charged as if the student had attended. This includes absence from school due to illness.

It is your son/daughter's responsibility to check the timetable each week, as lessons are given on a rotational basis.

GCSE and A-level Students

The instrumental teachers are very understanding about the demands of GCSE and A-level qualifications. If you talk to your instrumental teacher, they will do their best to accommodate your lessons around your school timetable, and around your exams.
