Assemblies Policy



Assemblies take place in the Hall from 2.15 - 2.35pm (on a Fri 1:45 – 2:05pm). At this time tutor groups are either with tutors in tutorials or at a house or year assembly as signified by the published assemblies sheet.

Assemblies are taken by members of SMT, staff or visiting speakers and are overseen by a head of house. As many local clergy as possible are invited to provide a balanced view of religious issues.

Prompt registration is important to ensure pupils arrive for assembly on time.

Tutors should accompany their tutor groups to the hall and supervise their conduct in the assembly. Tutors are expected to attend assemblies for the full duration.
