How Your GCSE and Vocational Grades will be determined.

Your teachers will use a range of evidence to determine your grade.

In each subject your teacher will tell you what evidence is being used. This will differ a little between subjects due to the nature of each course.

The evidence will include:

- Centre assessments More about these below.
- Non-exam assessment In subjects that have these eg: Product Design.
- Mock Exam
- Records of Performances In subjects such as PE and music.
- Records of your progress These will take into account class tests and significant homework tasks from across the course.
- If you take Art your portfolio will be used to determine your grade.

The grades for all the above will be made available to you.

We will not be able to give you your final grade before results day which is now **Thursday 12th August**.

Centre Assessments:

- To get a good idea of what grade you are working at you will complete centre assessments for each of your courses.
- The centre assessments will take place in lessons between Monday 26th April and Thursday 27th May. They will be in your normal classroom with your teacher unless you have a particular exam access arrangement.
- The centre assessments will have been put together by your teachers based on materials from the exam boards. These materials are not available until the end of March but as soon as your teacher knows what will be covered in each assessment, **they will issue you with a revision list**.
- The centre assessments will only cover material you have been taught. You will be given plenty of notice of what you will be asked to do in each centre assessment and given time in lessons to revise.
- Centre assessments will be a maximum of **45 minutes long**. Some may be shorter. If you have specific exam access arrangements such as extra time or a reader these will be provided.
- **Different subjects will have different numbers of centre assessments** based on the nature of the course. **The times for centre assessments are based on the option blocks**. Your tutor will go through the attached timetable with you and your subject teachers will confirm the date for each assessment.
- The marking of centre assessments will be checked by another teacher to ensure the marking is fair. Teachers will keep your centre assessments in case they are needed as evidence when we talk to the exam boards.
- If you miss an assessment your teacher will try to arrange another time for you to sit it.
