YEAR 8 ART VISIT TO OXFORD – 17th OR 22nd NOVEMBER
Wednesday 17th 8G1, 8S1, 8O1, 8F1 (A-M by surname)
Monday 22nd 8S2, 8O2, 8F2, 8F1 (P-W by surname)

As part of the second unit of work in Year 8, pupils will be studying the artwork and artefacts of other cultures. The pupils will be visiting both the Pitt Rivers and Natural History Museums on the day of the visit; each museum will run introductory talks and sketchbook sessions with the pupils.

The trip is intended to act as a stimulus for their work and whilst at the museums they will be expected to collect ideas and information.

The details are as follows:

8:15 am – Arrive at school and get onto coaches
8:30 am – Depart from school
9:45 am – Arrive in Oxford
2.30pm – Leave Oxford to return to school
3.35pm – Expected time of return to school

Bring: A Biro, pencil and coloured pencils.
Camera if possible.
Pupils should bring a packed lunch and drink with them on the day (there is nowhere to buy food and drink onsite.)

Uniform: Full school uniform must be worn.

Cost: £13.00

Please provide any specific information asked for on Scopay in the comments box before making the payment. If permissible numbers are exceeded, a ballot will take place, for all pupils who have met the deadline. A list of pupils obtaining a place will be displayed in the Trip's Cabinet outside the Finance office. Refunds to unsuccessful pupils will be made shortly after the closing date.
